


The state of foreign residents in Tsuchiura

The number of foreign residents in Tsuchiura increased rapidly since the revision of the Immigration Control Law in 1990, and it reached 3,729 at a peak period. Deteriorating employment situation in the later recession and the Great Eastern Japan Earthquake decreased its number. At present, there are many foreign residents in Tsuchiura, which number is about 4 times increase compared with 1990.

The trends of foreign residents by nationality show that the Philippines and Chinese nationals have been increasing recently. Including the Brazilian nationality, the three nationals compose about over 60% of foreign residents.

The number of permanent residents has been increasing, showing tendency of their lengthening of residing. There are also many trainees from Asian countries including China and Indonesia.

In Tsuchiura, the number of long stay foreign residents, including permanent residents, long-term residents, etc. has been increasing. Basically foreign residents should have rights and duties to receive appropriate administrative services as Japanese, and it is needed to consider them as the same Tsuchiura residents.


The time has come to develop mutual communication, provide an environment for foreign residents to participate in community development as members, respecting diversities of nationalities, culture, and lifestyle, and multicultural community development will be developed in cooperation with residents, enterprises, relevant organizations and the city.

Residents' activities in communities. neighborhood/local associations are essential. Since there is no such thing as local community organization abroad, it is especially expected to promote awareness/understanding these organizations to foreign residents and their voluntary participation to exchange events as community members.



What administration will do

NGOs/enterprises are expected to conduct events including international exchange/understanding, foreign residents' self-dependence support, and coordinate between residents and administration. Enterprises are also expected to contribute to the community including foreign residents' employment opportunities, Japanese learning to

backup/cooperation for understanding multicultural society. The city is required to provide administrative

services to support foreign residents and establish guideline/plan related to multicultural society improvement for realizing multicultural society in cooperation with each relevant organization, while taking into consideration of each community.

Communication Support

Necessary information will be provided to foreign residents in multiple languages and 'basic Japanese' as well as communication support to prevent their isolation from communities. Learning opportunities will also be provided to them for their acquiring knowledge including Japanese culture and custom.
