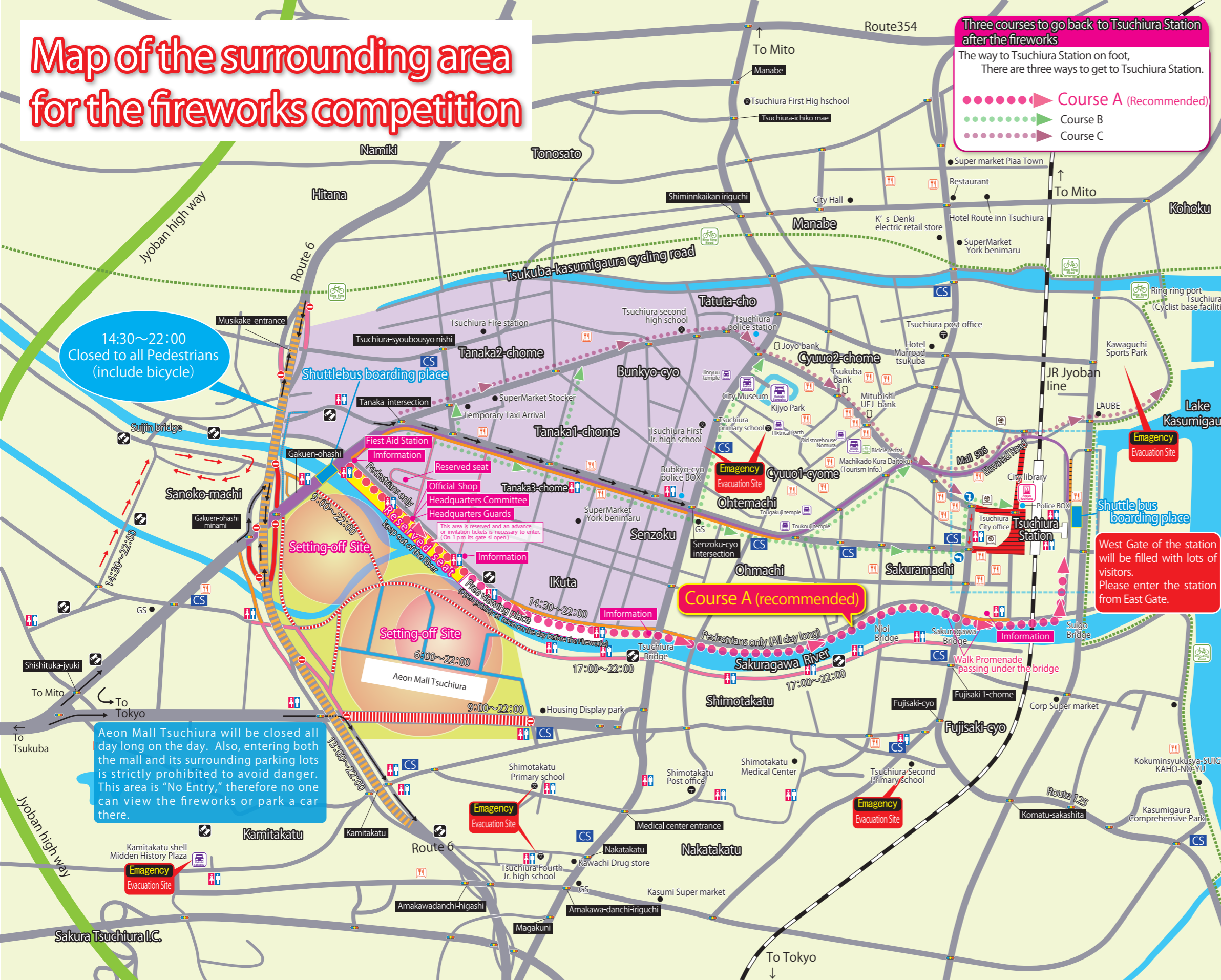


# Map of the surrounding area for the fireworks competition



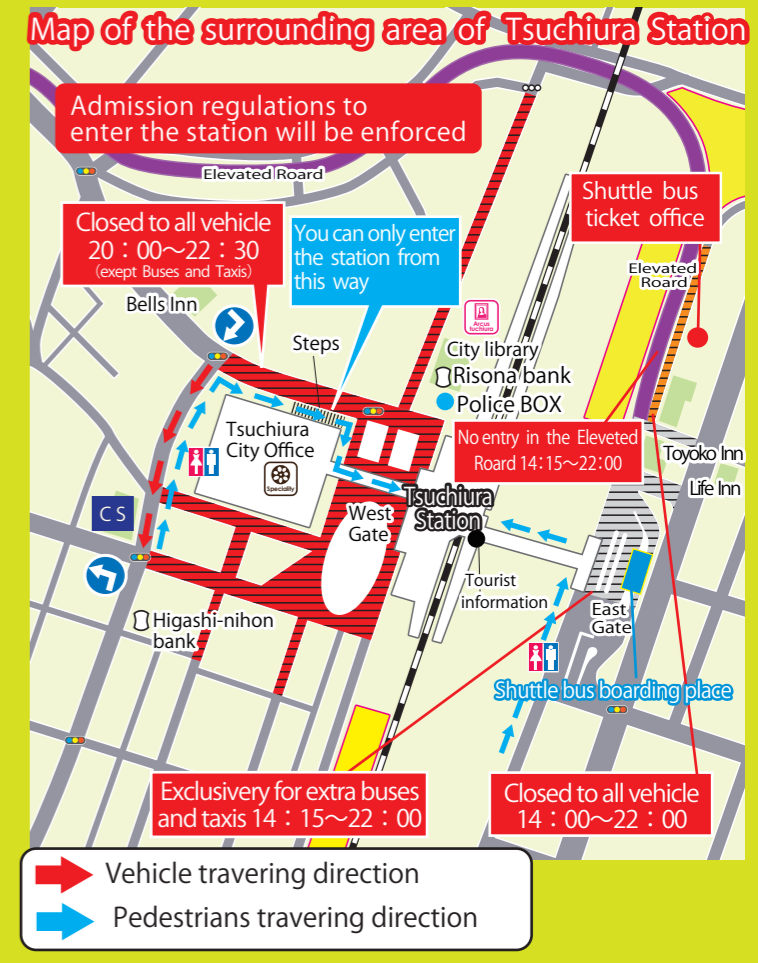
Three courses to go back to Tsuchiura Station after the fireworks  
 The way to Tsuchiura Station on foot, There are three ways to get to Tsuchiura Station.

- Course A (Recommended)
- Course B
- Course C

14:30~22:00  
 Closed to all Pedestrians (include bicycle)

Aeon Mall Tsuchiura will be closed all day long on the day. Also, entering both the mall and its surrounding parking lots is strictly prohibited to avoid danger. This area is "No Entry," therefore no one can view the fireworks or park a car there.

West Gate of the station will be filled with lots of visitors. Please enter the station from East Gate.



Keep out of the Sakuragawa River  
 From 15:00 to 21:00 entering the riverside between Gakuen-ohashi and Tsuchiura bridge is prohibited.

Off-limits areas  
 Do not enter the area colored because the fireworks set off in there, from 9:00 till 20:00

The fireworks site will be filled with lots of visitors.  
 If a disaster such as a big earthquake occurs, please avoid the crisis on your own.  
 In case of the instructions given by police officers and clerks in charge, stay calm and follow the instructions.

- Viewers' sites are roughly drawn on this map, so please move to a better place if fireworks are not seen well.
- Other than , the places drawn in this map, there are lots of places for viewers to enjoy the fireworks.
- If you are far from the setting-off area, "star mine" fireworks and the likes will not be seen well, but you can maybe avoid the after-fireworks-congestion.
- Depending on the wind direction, the fireworks will not be seen well by the smoke.
- Please understand that there will be a little change in the off-limits areas, so follow the instructions including signs.
- Please put waste in a garbage can.
- Toilet paper is not available in a restroom, so please bring tissue paper with you.
- Using of Small pilotless plane (DRONE) is prohibited around the fireworks venue and Setting-off Site.
